Δ Vaccine doses administered ≤ 4 days before the minimum interval or age are to be counted as valid.

* **DTP** - These can be a combination of DTP or DTaP. 5th dose required at school entry in Colorado. Only 4 doses are required if the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.

If the student is 7 years or older and has had 2 doses of DTP or DTaP, the student can be certified with a third dose of Td or DT, if it is given 6 months or more from the second dose. If the student is 7 years or older and has not had the required number of Pertussis doses, no additional doses are required until 6th grade. See rules for TDAP.

Ω **TDAP** – This is in addition to DTP requirements. To be given beginning at 10-11 years of age. If the student had a Td or DT they can wait 2 years to receive the TDAP.

** **Polio** - 4th dose required at school entry in Colorado. Only 3 doses are required if the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday. Four doses are a complete series regardless of age at completion.

§ **MMR** – 1st dose must have been administered on or after the first birthday and 2nd dose at least 28 days later.

∞ **Varicella** - must have been given on or after the first birthday and 2nd dose at least 28 days later. If the 1st dose of Varicella was given at ≥ 13 years, 2 doses are required separated by a minimum of 4 – 8 weeks. Documented history of the disease by a health care provider is acceptable.

† **HIB** – If the 1st dose was given ≥ 15 months only 1 dose required. If series began before first birthday - 3 doses required, with 3rd dose on or after 1st birthday. If series began between 12 and 14 months - 2 doses required. If student is 5 years or older - no new or additional doses required.

≈ Written evidence of a laboratory test showing immunity for a specific disease is acceptable.
