- Δ Vaccine doses administered  $\leq 4$  days before the minimum interval are to be counted as valid.
- \* **DTP** - These can be a combination of DTP or DTaP. 5th dose required at school entry in Colorado. Only 4 doses are required if the 4th dose was given on or after the 4th birthday.  
If the student is 7 – 10 years old and has had 2 doses of DTP or DTaP, the student can be certified with a third dose of Td or DT, if it is given 6 months or more from the second dose. If the student is 10 years or older and has not had the required number of Pertussis doses, the student can be certified with a dose of TDaP.
- Ω **TDaP** – This is in addition to DTP requirements. To be given beginning at 10-11 years of age. If the student had a Td or DT they can wait 2 years to receive the TDaP.
- \*\* **Polio** - 4th dose required at school entry in Colorado. Only 3 doses are required if the 3rd dose was given on or after the 4th birthday. Four doses are a complete series regardless of age at completion.
- § **MMR** – 1<sup>st</sup> dose cannot be administered more than 4 days before the first birthday and the 2nd dose should be at least 28 days later.
- ^ **Hepatitis B** – 2<sup>nd</sup> dose should be administered at least 4 weeks after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose. The 3<sup>rd</sup> dose should be administered at least 16 weeks after the 1<sup>st</sup> dose and at least 8 weeks after the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. The final dose should be no sooner than 24 weeks or 6 months of age. Enforcement of the spacing will be for Kindergarten students only.
- ∞ **Varicella** - 1<sup>st</sup> dose cannot be administered more than 4 days before the first birthday. Documented history of the disease by a health care provider is acceptable.
- † **HIB** – If the 1st dose was given  $\geq 15$  months only 1 dose required. If series began before first birthday - 3 doses required, with 3rd dose on or after 1st birthday. If series began between 12 and 14 months - 2 doses required. If student is 5 years or older - no new or additional doses required.
- ≈ Written evidence of a laboratory test showing immunity for a specific disease is acceptable.

Medical, religious, and personal exemptions continue to apply. Any information distributed by a school must include a statement that these exemptions are allowed in Colorado.
