REHEARSALS

We have rehearsals every Friday when school is full day session. These would be Fridays on Jan 16, 30, Feb 6, 13, 20, 27, Mar 6, 13, April 3, 10, 17, 24.

The Leads must attend each rehearsal. The Extra Townspeople and the Intermission Entertainment will attend rehearsals during the month of April.

Grades **MUST** be up in order for your child to be in this play. We will be checking on a weekly basis to make sure your child can be in the play. **Once your child is not able to attend rehearsal because of their grades, they will automatically be replaced in the play by a new cast member and will not be allowed to return to the play.**

Middle school children must have a **C** or **better** in ALL subjects!
Elementary is a grade of **S** or **better** in ALL subjects!

TECH-WEEK

Then we have 'Tech-Week', when we run the play from beginning to end, and use make-up, costumes, sounds, lights, etc. **TECH WEEK** is Monday **April 27th** thru **Thursday April 30th** everyday after school from **3:30-5:30 PM**. **Therefore - only the children that attend ALL REHEARSALS and TECH WEEK** will be allowed to be in the production.

PERFORMANCES

Cast A will have two performances. One at 7:00 PM on Friday May 1st and then Saturday May 2nd at 11:00 AM.

Cast B will have a Saturday May 2nd performance at 2:00 PM and then again at 6:00 PM.

STRIKE

PLUS ALL Cast Members and their families need to be at 'strike' to take down the set following the last performance on May 2nd. A cast party will take place immediately following the strike.

FEES

The main cast members will have a cost of \$40 to be in the play. This money is due before the end of February. The cost will include a script, make-up, props and two tickets to the play. Costume guidelines will be sent home shortly. Parents are responsible for either making or renting their child's costume. Also, these cast members will need to be at the first rehearsal on Friday January 16th.

As for the Extra Town's people roles, because we are adding these roles to the script, we will NOT have a \$40 fee for the kids. Costumes guidelines will be sent home shortly the as the parents will still need to purchase or rent the costume. The Extra Town's people will need come to the first Friday in April - the 3rd and attend all of the April rehearsals, including Tech Week (April 27-30).

As for the Intermission Entertainment kids - we will be adding a show between the two acts for these kids. We will NOT have a \$40 fee and rehearsal information will follow home shortly. Do not plan for these kids to attend rehearsal until April.
