Thank you in advance for all of your used items—if you have any questions or are interested in volunteering for the Clothing Sale please call Julie Stordahl at 303-503-7331!!

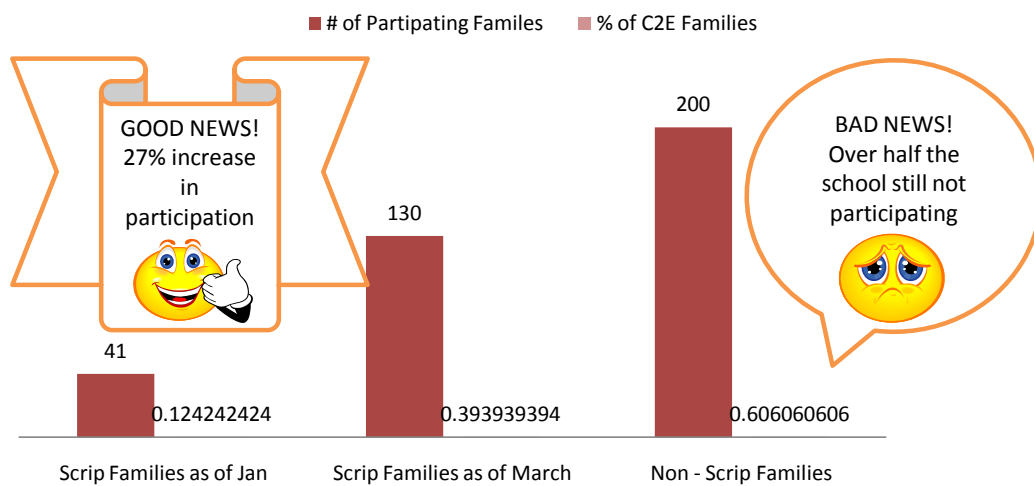
Make sure you come check out our new lunchroom at the End of Year Picnic! You will get a glimpse into the wonderful new hot lunch program as you share a lunch with your kids.

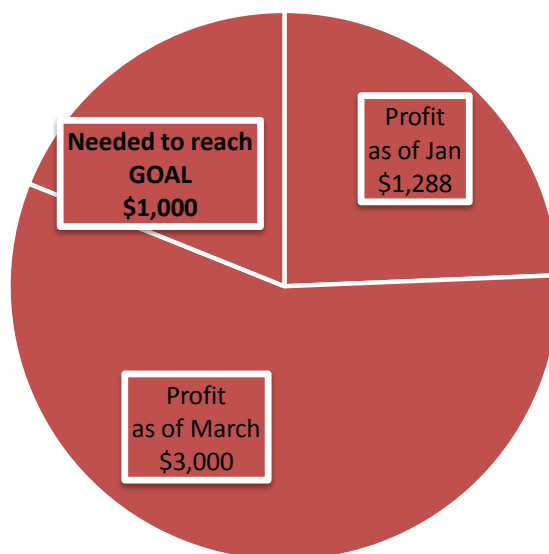
